



RESPONSES PRESENTED IN PIE-CHARTS




2. There is full freedom in the college to adopt new techniques / strategies of teaching such as group discussions, seminar presentations and learners' participation.




3. Assessment Tests and examinations are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus.






5. ICT facilities in the college are adequate and satisfactory.




6. Classrooms / laboratory / library / washrooms /college campus are clean and properly maintained.




7. Separate space in college Canteen is available for teachers.




8. The college provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty members for upgrading their skills and qualifications.

FEEDBACK ANALYSIS:

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Maharaja Bir Bikram College, Agartala, Tripura has conducted an online survey to get feedback from the teachers regarding the overall performance of the institution in terms of teaching-learning, curriculum, data & records maintenance, academic infrastructures (*i.e.*, library, classrooms, laboratories, etc.), provision of clean drinking water, sanitation and so on. All the teachers have whole-heartedly responded to the questionnaire honestly and have given their observations on these various aspects which reflects in the survey report.

With regard to the course/syllabi of the subjects taught in the semesters (which is framed by the affiliating University Board of Under-graduate Studies of respective subjects) it was found that, 23.2 percent of the teachers 'strongly agreed' to the relevance with modern thinking & ideas. This was followed by 69.6 percent who 'agreed'. Thus, the data shows that the total of 92.8 percent of the teachers were affirmative to the statement.

50 percent of the teachers 'agreed' and 41.1 percent 'strongly agreed' that there is full freedom to adopt new techniques or strategies of teaching.

The assessment tests and university examinations are conducted strictly on the basis of academic calendar well in time. The teachers, with their utmost sincerity, try to complete the syllabus in the class along with revision of the units, if time permits. This is reflected in the survey as well, where 57.1 percent 'agreed' and 39.3 percent 'strongly agreed' to the statement.

55.4 percent of the teachers 'agreed' on the view that the prescribed reference books/journals are available in the library in sufficient numbers. Only 5.4 percent 'strongly agreed' to the statement. It is also a matter of great concern that 23.2 percent of the teachers who 'disagreed' this statement. Hence, this is a matter of great concern which needs due attention.

44.6 percent of the teachers 'agreed' that ICT facilities in the college are adequate & satisfactory. 25 percent preferred to be 'indifferent' in this regard. A significant number of 21.4 percent of the teachers 'disagreed' with this statement. This area also needs proper attention.

Regarding proper cleanliness and maintenance of Classrooms / laboratory / library / washrooms /college campus, 30.4 percent of the teachers 'disagreed' and 5.4 percent 'strongly disagreed' with a total of 35.8 percent negating the statement. 32.1 percent 'agreed' and 7.1 percent 'strongly agreed' on the issues of cleanliness.

50 percent of the teachers 'agreed' and 7.1 percent 'strongly agreed' on the issue of separate space for teachers in college canteen. 16.1 percent, however, 'disagreed' with this statement.

80.3 percent of the respondents admitted that the college authority provides them adequate opportunities and support to faculty members in upgrading their skills and qualifications. The other responses were 58.9 percent preferred to 'agree' and 21.4 percent who 'strongly agreed' to this query.

On the criteria of availability of clean drinking water in the college premises, a negligible number of the respondents that is 7.1 percent have 'strongly agreed' and another 35.7 percent 'agreed'. On the other hand, 33.5 percent 'disagreed' to this particular question whereas 23.2 percent preferred to remain 'indifferent'. Hence, it appears that 57.1 percent respondents do not agree that clean drinking water is available in the college for all and the issue may be dealt with utmost priority.

The data, documents, records and evidences are well maintained according to 76.8 percent of the respondents, of which 66.1 percent 'agreed' and 10.7 percent 'strongly agreed' to the statement. And a merely of 7.1 percent of the teachers 'disagreed' to this query.
