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Executive Summary:

This report presents a formal analysis of the student feedback collected for the academic year 2022-23 at Maharaja Bir Bikram College (MBB College). The feedback primarily focuses on two key aspects: Academic Performance and Campus Ambience. The data gathered provides valuable insights into student perspectives and areas that require attention and improvement.

Academic Performance:

Strengths:

- A significant portion of students praised the teaching quality in various departments, citing outstanding faculty members and their dedication to imparting knowledge.
- Many students expressed gratitude for the guidance and support they received from professors.
- Some students highlighted that their academic experience at MBB College has contributed positively to their personal and intellectual growth.

Areas for Improvement:

- A notable portion of students expressed concerns about the syllabus and exam patterns, indicating that these aspects may induce stress and hinder overall academic performance.
- Several students suggested revising the syllabus to make it more manageable and relevant to future career prospects.
- Complaints were raised about the exam schedule, including the duration of semesters and the lack of adequate preparation time between exams.
- There were requests for better communication regarding the exam routine.

Campus Ambience:

Strengths:

- Some students commended the college for providing a peaceful and conducive environment for learning.
- A few students appreciated the green spaces and the effort made to maintain cleanliness on campus.
- A handful of students mentioned that the college atmosphere encourages extracurricular activities and cultural events.

Areas for Improvement:

- A significant number of students highlighted concerns related to the college's infrastructure. This includes outdated buildings, classrooms, and laboratory facilities.
- Many students expressed dissatisfaction with the lack of proper maintenance of washrooms and the need for improved sanitation facilities.
- Several students requested modernization and renovation of classrooms, including the installation of ceiling fans and better seating arrangements.
- There were complaints about the shortage of laboratory equipment, outdated chemicals, and a need for practical instrument upgrades.
- Students recommended enhancing security by installing CCTV cameras on campus.

Additional Comments by Students:


- Requests for more up-to-date textbooks and study materials.
