This report presents a formal analysis of the student feedback collected for the academic year 2023 – 2024 at Maharaja Bir Bikram College (MBB College). The feedback primarily focuses on two key aspects: Academic performance and Campus Ambience. The data gathered provides valuable insights into student perspectives that require attention and improvement.

The students' feedback on curriculum and teaching learning process at Maharaja Bir Bikram College, Agartala, is designed to get formative feedback from students that can be used towards the improvements in the quality of course design and delivery, as well as student learning experience. For the academic year 2023-2024 students' feedback is sought about the curriculum and teaching learning process, i.e., academic performance and campus ambience.

Majority of the student population agreed that the syllabus is very much challenging and the allocation of credits is appropriate in relation to the level of their studies. A significant number of the students strongly agreed that the syllabus is covered by the teachers on time with full dedication. A high percentage of the students agreed that the content provided in the syllabus is well sequenced and equipped them with necessary skills required for their professional areas after completion of their studies. Also majority of students agreed that the laboratory experiences and practical exposure given to them enhanced their understanding of the concepts and enable them to relate the theoretical components to practice.

Significant Observations:

- The analysis of the students' feedback clearly depicts that they are well satisfied with the curriculum development.
- The students highly appreciated the academic related infrastructural facilities such as library, laboratories, playground and other facilities.
- It is observed from the students' feedback that few of them expressed the need of more ICT facilities.
- The students were very satisfied by the curriculum delivery by the teachers and majority responded that teachers always communicate effectively.
- A significant percentage of students responded that they find their campus completely eco-friendly and hazard free environment.

This comprehensive report presents the analysis of the teachers' feedback gathered during the academic year 2023 – 2024 at Maharaja Bir Bikram College (MBB College). The feedback is centered around two vital areas: Academic performance and Campus Ambience. The valuable insights shared by our esteemed faculty members provide a nuanced perspective on the institution's strengths and areas requiring attention and improvement.

Feedback on various aspects of curriculum is sought from faculty members of Maharaja Bir Bikram College, Agartala. The aspects such as provision of adequate time and resources for framing syllabus, coverage of both theoretical and practical components in the syllabus, the coherence of the syllabus with programme outcomes, focus on necessary teaching skills, ensuring components that inculcate ethical values, focus on flexible curriculum based on current trends etc. As teachers play a pivotal role in designing and implementing the curriculum, the inputs received from their feedback was taken into consideration for further necessary action wherever applicable. Majority of the teachers stated that syllabus is framed with major focus on necessary skills required for completion of students' undergraduate degree. Majority of the teachers responded that they strongly agree that curriculum is flexible for enrichment, revision and modification based on recent trends and innovative ideas. 100 percent of the teachers agreed that they have the freedom to adopt new teaching strategies for curriculum strategies.

Significant Observations:

- The analysis of the teachers' feedback reflects the adequacy and availability of teaching-learning facilities.
- The feedback from the teachers revealed the validity and adequacy of the syllabus. Also, it is quite helpful in reframing the course content according to the societal needs.
- Various suggestions related to the modifications in the curricular content are noted for further necessary action.
