

Report on Wall Magazine and e-Magazine Publication

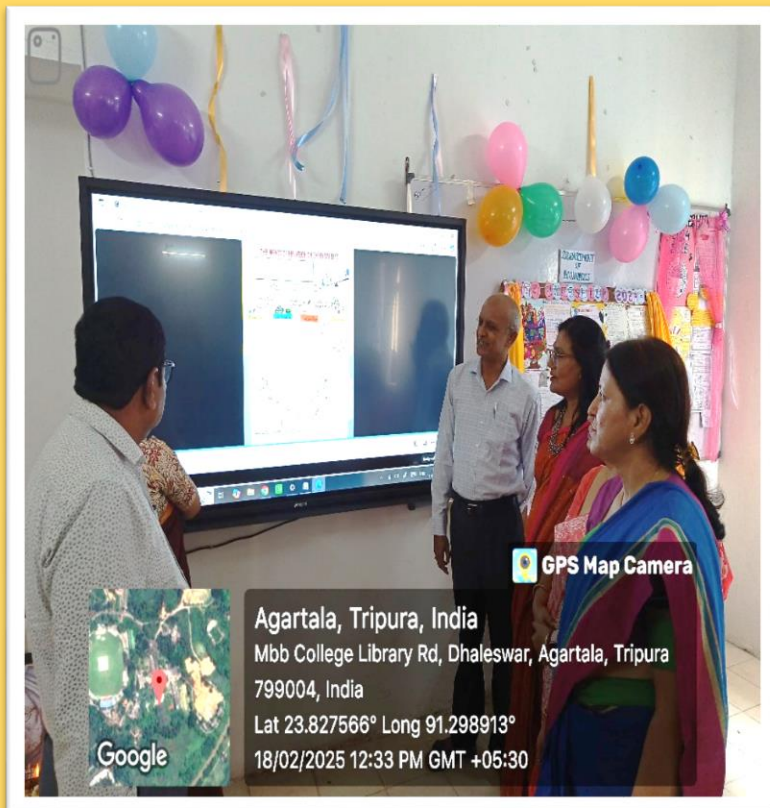

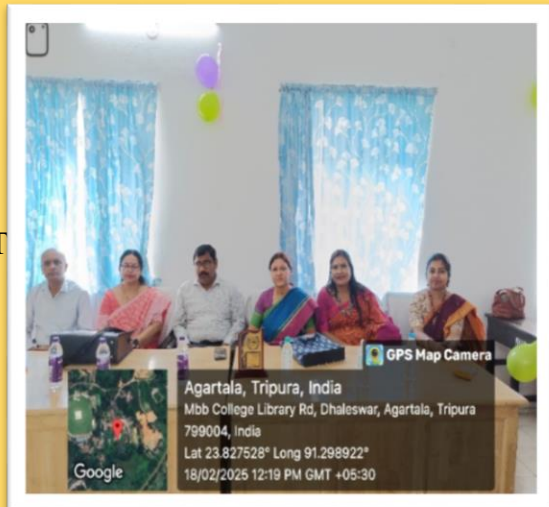

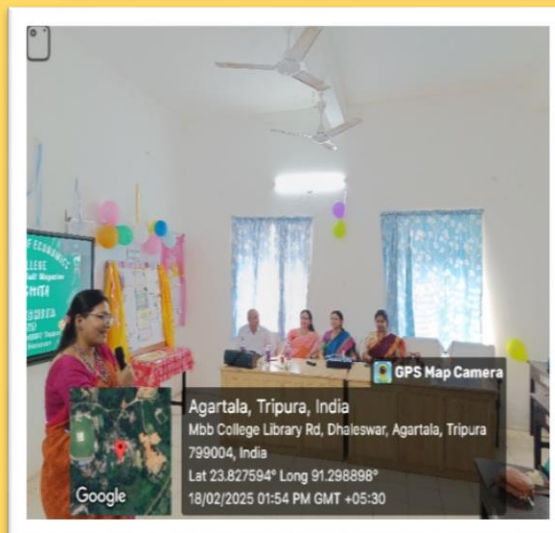
Bandyopadhyay, faculty of the department recited a poem. Senior pass out students of the Department shared their experiences as a
